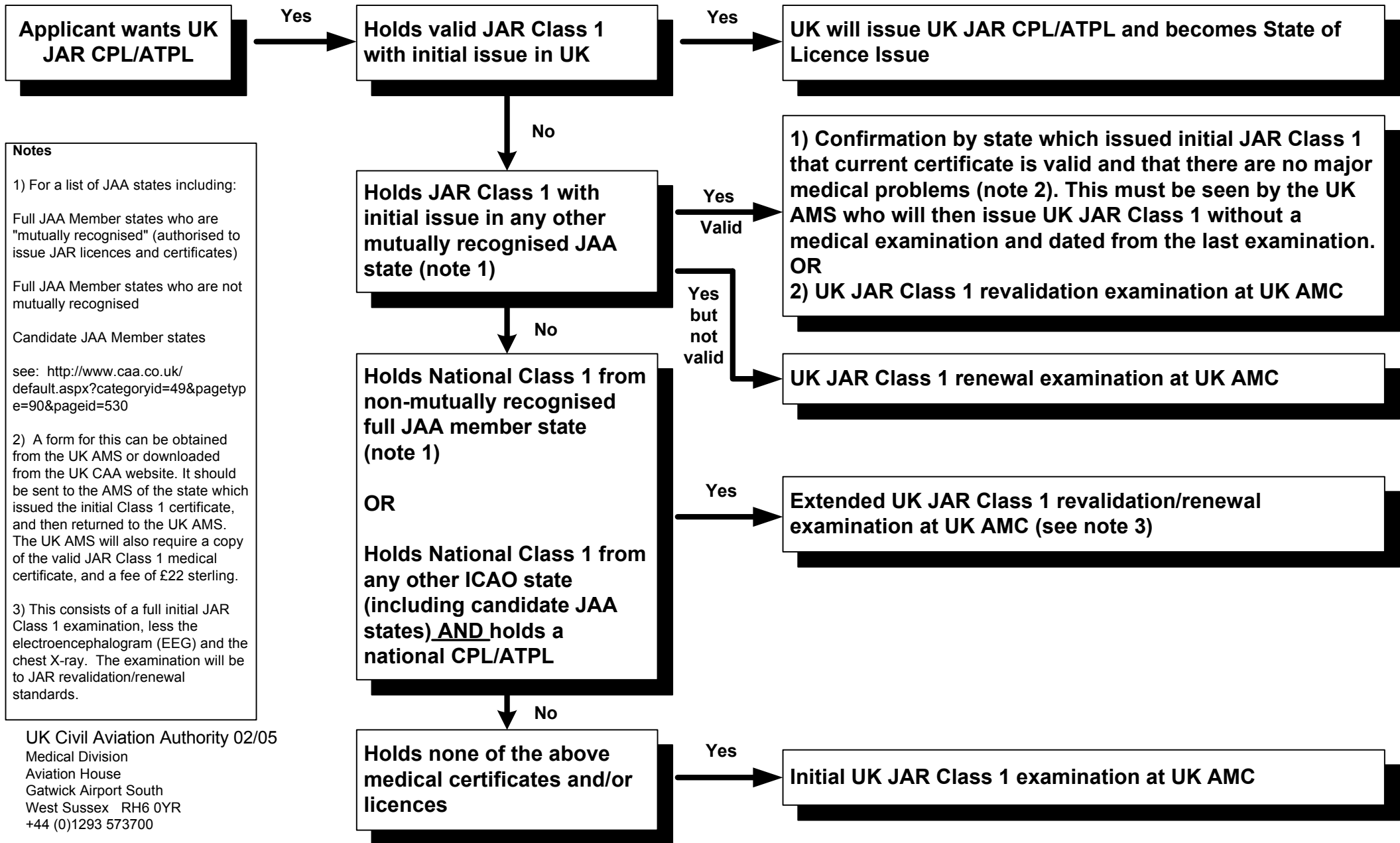


# Medical Certification for pilots requiring a UK JAR Commercial Pilot's Licence



**Notes**

1) For a list of JAA states including:

2) A form for this can be obtained from the UK AMS or downloaded from the UK CAA website. It should be sent to the AMS of the state which issued the initial Class 1 certificate, and then returned to the UK AMS. The UK AMS will also require a copy of the valid JAR Class 1 medical certificate, and a fee of £22 sterling.

3) This consists of a full initial JAR Class 1 examination, less the electroencephalogram (EEG) and the chest X-ray. The examination will be to JAR revalidation/renewal standards.
