Modem Installation – Windows XP

The following procedure applies regardless of which type of data cable is used to connect to the Thurara Gen 1 Handset





Click on the Start button, then select Control Panel





Select Switch to Classic View





Double Click on Phone and Modem Options





Select the **Modems** tab in the pop up window





Click on the Add button





Tick the box marked **Don't detect my modem; I will select it** from a list, then click on **Next**





Select Standard Modem Types, then select a Standard 19,200 bps Modem and click on Next





Choose which **COM port** you want to install the modem on and click on **Next**

Wait while Windows installs your modem

Click on Finish

You will then see the following screen, your modem has been successfully installed. Click on **OK**

Enter the Phone number for your dial up connection and click on Next

Plug in the USB > Serial convertor.

The Found New Hardware Wizard will appear, select **No, not this time** and click on **Next**

Insert the CD supplied with the convertor.

Select Install the software automatically and click on Next

The Found New Hardware Wizard will run automatically

The Found New Hardware Wizard will show that it has finished installing the software, click on **Finish**

Go to Control Panel > Device Manager

Select ports (COM & LPT) and make a note of the port number assigned to the USB > Serial convertor

USB Data Cable Installation

Insert the CD supplied with the cable. The CD will autorun and this screen will appear

Select INSTALLATION FOR WIN 98 / 2000 / XP

Select Run

A Security Warning will appear, stating the publisher could not be verified

Select Run

The InstallShield Wizard will appear

Select Next

The InstallShield Wizard will show installation complete

Select Finish

Plug in the USB cable. You will see windows autodetect the cable & confirm new hardware is ready to use.

Go to Control Panel > Device Manager, select Ports (COM & LPT) and make a note of the port number assigned to the **Prolific USB to Serial Comm Port**
